As a result of a 1998 Air Force Audit Agency study recommendation to improve visibility over materials and to control contractor access to material in the DOD supply system at Newark, the contractors and DOD have performed a detailed inventory of material on-hand and instituted new record keeping procedures and controls. As a result, neither the Air Force nor the Defense Contract Management Command view the material cost issue as an ongoing factor in terms of increased privatization costs. The November 1998 updated cost study assumed that material costs were the same for both the contractor and the government. While the Air Force cost studies indicate operations are more costly at the privatized facility, the contractors have been incorporating business improvements to obtain cost efficiencies in order to reduce their operating costs.
