It is only partially soluble in cold water, but freely so in hot water, coloring the water a light yellowish brown. Physiological Action. Circulation. -Owing to an impression produced upon the vagi, thialion, in therapeutic doses, slows and lengthens the contractions of the heart, causing a slight fall in the pulse rate; while at the same time its inhibitory action on the vaso-motor nerves lowers arterial tension and gives rise to a freer...
